## I. CALL TO ORDER

III. MASSACHUSETTS BAY COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD CHAIR'S REMARKS
Mr. Jon Bower, chair of Massachusetts Bay Community College board of trustees,
described the presidential search process. This included:

The search committee narrowed the candidate field to 9 semi-finalists, then to 3 finalists, and, ultimately, the board of trustees voted unanimously to recommend Dr. John O'Donnell as the next candidate for President of Massachusetts Bay Community College.

Chairman Desmond invited presidential candidate Dr. John O'Donnell to the microphone. The members of the Board of Higher Education introduced themselves and, at the invitation of the Chairman, asked questions of Dr. O'Donnell regarding his vision for MassBay, the impression he has left on the students of Stark State University, his growth of enrollment and minority enrollment at Stark State, and his past community outreach efforts. Additional questions focused on financial accountability and performance funding.

Chair Desmond thanked Dr. O'Donnell for his participation.
