Dear Deputy Commissioner Wallerstein,

MCLA appreciates the continued support from the Department of Higher Education for the alternative tuition program for New York State residents. We wanted to provide you with this information in advance of the next BHE fiscal affairs meeting scheduled for March 28, 2023.

The DHE has consistently authorized MCLA to enroll new students from New York State at a rate (\$1,545) that mirrors that charged to students under the New England Regional Student Program through the New England Board of Higher Education. Currently, 125 students receive the benefits of the alternative tuition program. We also wish to continue the program at the same rate.

By capitalizing on our proximity to New York State, this important program has supported sustained enrollment while not displacing any Massachusetts students. We are pleased with the results to date and look forward to continuing with this alternative tuition program for New York students, and maintain the 306 new student limit, already in place.
