Background

Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 15A, Section 9(i), provides that the Board of Higher Education shall annually set tuition rates for the state universities and the community colleges. The recommendation is for all FY2017 tuition rates to remain the same as the current tuition rates. Note: In FY17, tuition rates for the University of Massachusetts will be set by the University of Massachusetts Board Of Trustees in accordance with Tuition Retention legislation passed in the FY16 General Appropriations Act (GAA).
