#### **FISCAL YEAR 2011 CASH GRANT AWARDS**

## **Background**

The Cash Grant Program is designed to assist students with financial need in meeting mandatory fees and non-state-supported tuition and is a complementary program to the Need-Based Tuition Waiver Program.

Funding for the Cash Grant Program, currently \$32,989,065, is determined by the annual appropriation for state financial aid. Each year, the Board of Higher Education votes on how these funds will be distributed among the campuses.

As with tuition waivers, Cash Grant awards are allocated in proportion to aggregate student financial need at each institution. For FY2011, the Board will vote to hold allocations consistent with the current FY2010 levels. A newly revised funding formula that is more reflective of individual campuses' aggregate financial aid need will be considered for future allocations, commencing with FY2012. This new formula model follows recommendations from the Task Force on Student Financial Aid report, as accepted by the Board of Higher Education in 2005, which encouraged the allocation of need-based state financial aid to institutions whose students demonstrate the greatest financial need.

Allocations are based on an assumption of level funding of the Cash Grant Program in FY2011. The Board of Higher Education may revise the allocations if future state appropriations for financial aid were to differ, requiring an adjustment in the proposed allocations.
