## Cape Cod

For FY2002, Cape Cod ceased matriculating Certified Nurse Aide students and ceased awarding formal certificates to Certified Nurse Aide students who successfully completed the seven credit course of study. Students completed the course of study and were positively placed, but did not receive certificates. This change is reflected in the decrease in the number of total certificates ( 96 certificates) reported to IPEDS for FY2002, compared to FY2001 (127 certificates) and prior years. For FY2001, 36 Nurse Assistant/Aide certificates were conferred. For FY2002, none were conferred. The FY1997-FY2002 \# Change (-60) and \% Change (-12.5\%) were affected by the change in practice effective FY2002 discontinuing matriculation of and conferral of certificates on Nurse Aide students.

## Regions of Massachusetts

(Massachusetts Department of Economic Development breakdown)

Berkshire Region
Massachusetts' western most region is defined by the 32 communities that constitute Berkshire County. Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts and Berkshire Community College are the two system institutions in the region.


## Pioneer Valley Region:

Franklin, Hampden, and Hampshire Counties define the Pioneer Valley along with the Worcester County communities of Athol, Petersham, Phillipston, and Royalston. UMassAmherst, Westfield State College, and Greenfield, Holyoke, and Springfield Technical Communities Colleges are located in this region.

## Central Region:

All but four of the 54 cities and towns in the Central Region are part of Worcester County (Ayer, Groton, Pepperell, Shirley, and Townsend are part of Middlesex County). Fitchburg and Worcester State Colleges, Quinsigamond and Mount Wachusett Community Colleges, and the UMass-Worcester Medical School are located in this region.


## Northeast Region:

The Northeast contains all of Essex County and nine communities (Bedford, Billerica, Chelmsford, Dracut, Dunstable, Lowell, Tewksbury, Tyngsborough, and Westford) from the northern portion of Middlesex County. UMass-Lowell, Salem State College and Middlesex, North Shore, and Northern Essex Community Colleges are located in this region.


## Greater Boston Region:

All of Suffolk, a majority of Middlesex and Norfolk, and communities from the eastern edge of Worcester and northern edge of Plymouth Counties make up Greater Boston. UMassBoston, Framingham State College, MassArt, and Bunker Hill, Mass Bay, and Roxbury Community Colleges are located in this region.


## Southeast Region:

All of Bristol County and the southern portion of Plymouth County as well as the Norfolk County communities of Avon, Canton, Foxborough, Plainville, Sharon, and Stoughton constitute the Southeast Region. UMass-Dartmouth, Bridgewater State College, and Bristol and Massasoit Community Colleges are located in the Southeast Region.
