

APPENDIX A

Degrees Conferred

For FY2002, Cape Cod ceased matriculating Certified Nurse Aide students and ceased awarding formal certificates to Certified Nurse Aide students who successfully completed the seven credit course of study. Students completed the course of study and were positively placed, but did not receive certificates. This change is reflected in the decrease in the number of total certificates (96 certificates) reported to IPEDS for FY2002, compared to FY2001 (127 certificates) and prior years. For FY2001, 36 Nurse Assistant/Aide certificates were conferred. For FY2002, none were conferred. The FY1997-FY2002 # Change (-60) and % Change (-12.5%) were affected by the change in practice effective FY2002 discontinuing matriculation of and conferral of certificates on Nurse Aide students.

Berkshire Region:




Pioneer Valley Region:



Northeast Region:




Greater Boston Region:


