#### MassReconnect Overview

MassReconnect is designed to encourage Massachusetts adults, age 25 and older, to enroll in college for the first time or return to college to complete a program of study

MassReconnect will provide grants to full and part-time community college students to cover the costs of tuition, fees, books and supplies for a certificate or associate degree

## MassReconnect Overview

- MassReconnect is funded at \$20 million by all sectors under the FY24 budget process: Governor's H1, HWM and SWM. Legislative Language is consistent and stipulates that the program must:
  - Support community college students, age 25 and older, who
    - have not previously earned a college degree
    - Enrolled in a minimum of six credits
  - Cover the cost of tuition, fees, books and supplies
  - Awarded as a last dollar grant, after all sources of federal and state aid is considered
  - May be used to support summer educational programs

## MassReconnect Stakeholder Engagement

- MassReconnect guidelines were developed in partnership with stakeholders
- DHE participated in weekly planning meetings with the Massachusetts Association of Community Colleges (MACC)
- DHE sponsored a webinar to share MassReconnect concepts and to receive further input/feedback from community college professionals. Participants included campus presidents and key administrators (academic deans, financial aid administrators, student support service advisers, etc.)

## MassReconnect Outreach & Communications

- A Strategic Communications & Outreach Plan is underway to attract diverse adult populations, and is designed to:
  - Inform potential adult students of opportunities available through MassReconnect
  - Encourage adults to consider college for the first time, or return to a campus to complete a program of study previously started
  - **Emphasize** the significance and value of earning a college credential
  - Focus on key communities and agencies for the target population
    - Leverage key calendar dates for awareness campaign (such as Black History, Asian American and Pacific Islander, and Hispanic Heritage Months)
  - Create Informative Landing Page key audience engagement; connects student with campus; real stories
  - **Connects** MassReconnect with the DHE Equity Agenda priorities

## MassReconnect Outreach & Communications

To support the approval of MassReconnect on July 1, or as soon as the FY24 budget is final, the DHE, supported by C+C, will create and share a comprehensive initial content package that includes:

- News release
- One sheet program overview
- Landing page copy
- Graphics for that can be shared with key stakeholders
- Recommended social content
- Paid social media recommendations
- Email to students in DHE database

## MassReconnect Key Timeline

- MassReconnect will commence with the 2023-24 academic year
  - Campuses informed of funding immediately after FY24 budget is final
- Concentrated Communications and Strategic Outreach:
  - June 2023 September 2023, with continued outreach throughout the year and around specific semester enrollment dates
- Training Workshops for stakeholders July 11 & 12
  - community college staff (financial aid, admissions, etc.), with continued campus support throughout the academic year

## MassReconnect Recommendations

 Staff will recommend that the BHE approve the MassReconnect program guidelines, contingent upon the FY24 budget
