

# **Building a STEM Pipeline**

In academic year 2015-16, MassBay saw an increased participation in SSA-sponsored events designed to recruit students to the college's STEM programs. In fall 2015, **14** events were held with **350** participants, and in spring 2016, **30** events were held with **506** participants.



45% of mentees are women

24% mentees are the first in their family to attend college

52% of mentees are students of color

## **STEM Mentor Program**

Supporting Retention and Diversity

Mentee retention rate from fall 2015 to spring 2016 was **89%** as compared to the overall fall to spring STEM retention rate which was **69%**.

#### SSA-FUNDED EMBEDDED LEARNING SPECIALISTS

In AY 2015-16, SSA funded 12 embedded learning specialists (ELS) in 24 math classes



#### SERVING MASSBAY STUDENTS

These learning specialists served 112 STEM students and over 233 other MassBay students



#### SUPPORTING MATH SUCCESS

67% of students in ELS-supported classes passed with grades averaging between B and B+
