Notice is hereby given pursuant to [M.G.L. c. 69, § 30](#) and the [Massachusetts Board of Higher Education's Policy Establishing a Process for Public Comment on Articles of Organization and Foreign Certificates of Institutions of Higher Education that the Massachusetts Department of Higher Education](#) will open a comment period relative to **the Articles of Amendment filed by Fisher College to offer the Bachelor of Arts in Sociology.**

Fisher College is an approved independent institution in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts with the authority to grant the degrees of Master of Business Administration, Master of Science in Criminal Justice, Master of Arts in Counseling Psychology, Master of Arts in Psychology, Bachelor of Science in Marketing, Bachelor of Science in Nursing, Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice, Bachelor of Science in Human Services, Bachelor of Science in Management, Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Arts, Bachelor of Arts in Psychology, Bachelor of Arts in Communication and Media Studies, Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Education and Care, Bachelor of Science in Information Technology, Bachelor of Science in Human Resource Management, Bachelor of Science in Sports Management, Bachelor of Arts in Biology, Associate in Science and Associate in Arts, Certificates in Administrative Assistant, Computer Technology, Early Childhood Education, Medical Assistant, Paralegal Studies, Retail Merchandising, Retail Management, and Travel and Hospitality Management, and to confer honorary degrees in Doctor of Humane Letters, Associate in Science and Associate in Arts. Fisher College is now seeking the authority to offer the Bachelor of Arts in Sociology.
