Notice is hereby given pursuant to [M.G.L. c. 69, § 30](#) and the [Massachusetts Board of Higher Education's Policy Establishing a Process for Public Comment on Articles of Organization and Foreign Certificates of Institutions of Higher Education that the Massachusetts Department of Higher Education](#) will open a comment period relative to **the Articles of Amendment filed by Wentworth Institute of Technology to offer the Master of Science in Bioengineering.**

Wentworth Institute of Technology is an approved independent institution in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts with the authority to grant "degrees at the associate and baccalaureate levels in fields of science, engineering and technology; to confer appropriate honorary doctorate and ex officio degrees" and the following degrees: Master of Architecture, Master of Engineering in Civil Engineering, Master of Science in Business Analytics, Master of Science in Civil Engineering, Master of Science in Computer Science, Master of Science in Construction Management, Master of Science in Cybersecurity, Master of Science in Data Science, Master of Science in Electrical and Computer Engineering, Master of Science in Facility Management, Master of Science in Mechanical Engineering, Master of Science in Project Management, and Master of Science in Technology Management. Wentworth Institute of Technology is now seeking the authority to offer the Master of Science in Bioengineering.

The public comment period for the Articles of Amendment filed by Wentworth Institute of Technology to offer the Master of Science in Bioengineering begins on February 19, 2026, and will close three weeks thereafter, on March 12, 2026.
