NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD

Notice is hereby given pursuant to [M.G.L. c. 69, § 30](#) and the [Massachusetts Board of Higher Education's Policy Establishing a Process for Public Comment on Articles of Organization and Foreign Certificates of Institutions of Higher Education that the Massachusetts Department of Higher Education](#) will open a comment period relative to the **Articles of Amendment filed by Wentworth Institute of Technology to offer the Master of Science in Mechanical Engineering.**

Wentworth Institute of Technology is an approved institution in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts with the authority to grant the "... the right to grant degrees at the associate and baccalaureate levels in fields of science, engineering and technology; to confer appropriate honorary doctorate and ex officio degrees, together with the right to confer such other degrees as may be approved by the Board of Regents of Higher Education" (1984); Master of Architecture, Master of Science in Construction Management, Master of Science in Facility Management, Master of Science in Technology Management, Master of Engineering in Civil Engineering, Master of Science in Applied Computer Science, Master of Science in Project Management, Master of Science in Civil Engineering, Master of Science in Data Science, Master of Science in Business Analytics, Master of Science in Electrical Engineering, the Master of Science in Computer Engineering, and the Master of Science in Cybersecurity Analytics. In its current petition, Wentworth Institute of Technology is seeking authority to offer the Master of Science in Mechanical Engineering.

The public comment period for the Articles of Amendment filed by Wentworth Institute of Technology to offer the Master of Science in Mechanical Engineering begins on March 1, 2024 and ends on March 22, 2024.
