## **FY2023 Regular Board Meeting Schedule**

M.G.L. c. 15A, §4(f) requires the Board of Higher Education (BHE) to meet no fewer than six times per year, and at least once every two months, omitting meetings in the months of July and August. Additional meetings, as well as Special meetings, may be called by the Chair of the Board, at other times.

For state fiscal year 2023 (academic year 2022-2023), the following BHE regular<sup>1</sup> board meeting schedule is proposed:

- Tuesday, October 18
- Tuesday, December 13
- Tuesday, February 14
- Tuesday, March 28
- Tuesday, May 9
- Tuesday, June 20

The BHE's By-Laws delegate to the Chair of the BHE, in consultation with the Commissioner, the authority to fix the time and place of BHE regular board meetings. *By-Laws of the Massachusetts Board of Higher Education*, Article II, Section 1. All BHE regular Board meetings will begin at 10:00 a.m., unless otherwise designated by the Commissioner, in consultation with the Board Chair. The location of each meeting shall be determined by the Commissioner, in consultation with the Board Chair.

In addition, the BHE is committed to holding its Annual Meeting this fiscal year in the Fall, before the Board's first regular board meeting of the academic year. The date and time of the BHE's Annual Meeting shall be established by the Chair, in consultation with the Commissioner, after polling of BHE members for the availability of a quorum. The location of the Annual Meeting shall be determined by the Commissioner, in consultation with the Board Chair.
