The purpose of adopting this policy was to recognize the importance of naming opportunities on college campuses for the purposes of promoting fundraising and recognizing individuals who have made a significant professional contribution and/or provided distinguished service to the campus and/or the surrounding community. *See* FAAP 17-23. The policy established criteria and procedures for granting naming rights in relation to public State University and Community College buildings in Massachusetts. In accordance with, and in satisfaction of the requirements set forth in this policy, Cape Cod Community College is requesting approval of the naming of a new Science and Engineering Building in honor of Frank and Maureen Wilkens as the project's most notable private benefactors.
