Since funds will be limited in FY '16, late applications cannot be accommodated under any circumstances.

Carefully review the information provided before submitting the report. Please note that Section III requires that you report Pell Grant expenditures for <u>part-time</u> students only (regardless of whether these students received Part-Time Grant funds). You may include Pell expenditures for students who were enrolled part-time for at least one of the traditional academic semesters, fall or spring. Do not report Pell expenditures for full-time students who attended part-time only during a summer session. *Note: If your institution did not receive Part-Time Grant funds in FY 2015, you may complete Section III only, to be considered for a FY '16 allocation.*

Notification of the 2015-2016 Part-Time Grant allocations will be mailed by August 7, 2015, or as soon as possible. If OSFA does not receive a completed Reconciliation Report from your institution by the July 24, 2015 deadline, we will assume that your institution does not wish to participate in the Part-Time Grant program for the upcoming academic year. We are unable to reserve funds for institutions that fail to submit the enclosed report as requested.
