2013-2014 PROGRAMS GUIDELINES UPDATES

Dear Colleague:

This March 2014 Action Letter updates the Mass Transfer Tuition Waiver's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) requirement published in the Massachusetts Office of Student Financial Assistance (OSFA) Action Letter of January 2014.

Effective immediately, students who are attending Massachusetts public colleges and universities and are applying to the Mass Transfer Tuition Waiver in award year 2014-2015 and beyond, no longer must complete an appropriate year Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) in order to receive consideration for the above program.
