Massachusetts' MASSGrant Plus program was recently expanded to offer more benefits:

For Pell Grant-Eligible Students

Family adjusted gross income of approximately \$73,000 or less

Free tuition and fees
(not including housing)

+ \$1,200 allowance for books and supplies

For Middle-Income Students

Family adjusted gross income between \$73,000 and \$100,000

Up to half off tuition and fees
(not including housing)
