You are encouraged to apply for our **FREE** summer Transfer Academy, available to all MA community college STEM graduates who have been accepted for transfer to the UMassD in a STEM degree program for the Fall 2021 semester.

### **Program Overview:**

- Take a 3-credit, **tuition-free** online summer course at UMassD during the second 5-week session (July 12<sup>th</sup>-August 13<sup>th</sup>)
- Receive one-on-one advising
- Meet with STEM faculty and learn about research opportunities
- Connect with other transfer students through panel discussions and mentoring
- Become familiar with campus resources and support services

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must participate in required virtual orientation sessions/workshops during Summer 2021\*
- Must enroll in a Summer Session II course at UMassD as part of your STEM program of study

\*Students who complete the required orientation sessions and summer coursework will receive a stipend for their participation.
